4. **AMERICAN RED CROSS FIRST AID, CPR, AED INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION COURSE:** Congratulations to the 9 Commandants that completed the course held 16-18 November 2018 at Camp San Luis Obispo. The 9 Commandants are now certified to teach American Red Cross First Aid, CPR, and AED and other Red Cross Training. HQCACC is looking into offering more of these courses in the future.

 - b. No extra text on the spreadsheet
 - c. No notes
 - d. No non-name rows
 - e. No blank rows

 - a. Do not use Google docs
