1. STRENGTH AND ACTIVITIES REPORT (SAR): Remember to submit your SAR by the 10th of each month using the online system at <https://tools.cacadets.org/>. For step-by-step directions on how to submit your SAR visit <https://sway.office.com/mRBrQ8ce1FgPRQUL?ref=Link>. If you encounter problems submitting your SAR, send an email to itsupport@cacadets.org.
2. .22 CALIBER MARKSMANSHIP COMPETITION: will be held on Saturday, 8 February 2019 in San Luis Obispo. The Warning Order is published to <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. If your Unit plans are participating send an email to operations@cacadets.org ASAP.
3. STATE DRILL COMPETITION AND INDIVIDUAL MAJOR AWARDS COMPETITION: will be held 17-19 April 2020 at Camp Roberts. The Warning Order is published to <https://cacadets.org/circulars>. Note that the IMA competition is open enrollment – no requirement to win at BN/BDE level to compete.
4. SUMMER ENCAMPMENT: application portal is scheduled to open on 31 January 2020. We are seeking outstanding Cadet leaders to apply and serve as Leadership for Summer Encampment. Adult/Commandant personnel are also highly encouraged to apply for a Summer Encampment position. More information to follow in the coming weeks.

Note that there is only one Summer Encampment cost for this year; there will not be separate prices for attending one or two Encampments. Early Bird price (through March 15th) will be \$150.00 and regular price will be \$250.00. Scholarships will be available to help defray the cost for Summer Encampment. Watch the website in the coming weeks for additional information regarding Summer Encampment.

5. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING: for Adult/Commandant personnel will be held 8-9 February 2020 and will focus on Drill and Ceremonies. This training is designed for all experienced Adult personnel or those Adult personnel with little to no experience that would like additional hands on training in the area of Drill & Ceremonies to help better support the Cadets at your School and Brigade (or to just improve your drill ability). 6. UNIFORM REQUISITIONS: Continue to submit your uniform requisition requests via <https://cacadets.org/HQ/S4/Requisitions>. If you have any questions regarding your requisitions email logistics@cacadets.org.

7. ANNUAL GENERAL INSPECTION (AGI): will be conducted in February and March 2020. The Circular will be published soon, so begin reviewing CR 1-6.
8. NEW CR 1, GENERAL ADMINISTRATION: will be published by the end of the month and has significant changes that will make administrative practices at the unit level less cumbersome.
9. STAFF RIDE: We are currently looking at conducting a Staff Ride to San Francisco/Sacramento in July 2020. More details will be coming out in the coming weeks.
10. CACADETS.ORG EMAIL ACCOUNT: All Commandant personnel are required to have a cacadets.org email account and actively use it to receive communication from HQCACC. If you don't have a cacadets.org email or need assistance logging in, contact the HQCACC S-6 section, ITSupport@cacadets.org. We're managing a finite number of email address accounts, so there may be a slight delay getting an account. School Commandants have priority.
11. CALIFORNIA CADET CORPS WEBSITE: Our California Cadet Corps website is www.cacadets.org. Be sure you that you have registered for the CACC website so you receive emails when the site is updated and new announcements are posted.

13. NAMEPLATES: HQCACC is no longer able to make nameplates for cadets. They are available at The Cadet Store (with discount to CACC units - \$2 each). Commandant nameplates are also available for purchase.
14. NAMETAPES: Units have been enquiring about where to get nametapes made for the new Class C uniforms. www.maderauniform.com makes them (very expensive, though). We're talking to 1800nametapes to try and get the colors at a reasonable match.
