

## **WARNING ORDER 2018-2019-001**

### **1. SITUATION:**

- a. Name of Event/Operation: Drill Competition
- b. Date: 13 April 2019
- c. Start and End Times: Competition team leaders check in beginning at 0700. Event will conclude NLT 1700.
- d. Location: Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB)
- e. Brigades Participating: All Brigades with eligible teams.
- f. Participation Requirements: All unit teams who have placed first at their respective Brigade Drill Competitions are eligible to compete in this event. Brigades with a strength greater than 800 cadets are authorized to bring their first and second place winners for each Drill category. The competition will be conducted IAW CR 3-8.
- g. Training Events Planned: N/A

**2. MISSION:** The California Cadet Corps Annual Drill Competition, conducted 13 APR 2019, will improve cadet knowledge on drill and ceremonies by offering a state level competition between brigade level teams.

### **3. EXECUTION:**

a. Commander's Intent: To conduct a competitive event that provides unit teams with a healthy environment in which they have the opportunity to display their knowledge of drill. The event will be an excellent way for cadets and their respective units to perform and showcase their proficient drill and ceremonies abilities. A sense of unity and camaraderie will be encouraged at the event, thus resulting in a building of character and gaining of greater respect for their peers that can be passed on to our subordinate units aiding in promoting *Esprit de Corps. Essayons!*

b. Concept of Operations: The competition will be conducted at Joint Force Training Base (JFTB) Los Alamitos. Judges will be comprised of military personnel, augmented as necessary by CACC personnel. Winners will be recognized at the awards ceremony. Competitors can compete in 9 different categories:

- (1) Unarmed Squad (Junior and Senior Division)
- (2) Unarmed Platoon (Junior and Senior Division)
- (3) Color Guard (Junior and Senior Division)
- (4) Armed Squad
- (5) Armed Platoon
- (6) Armed Exhibition Drill
- (7) Unarmed Exhibition Drill
- (8) Individual Unarmed Drill Down (Grizzly, Junior & Senior Divisions)
- (9) Individual Armed Drill Down (Junior & Senior Divisions)

c. Goals:

- (1) Goal 1 is to create a safe and competitive environment for the cadets to showcase their CACC Drill knowledge.
- (2) Goal 2 is to enhance the cadet's self-confidence and sense of unity within respective teams in order to drill at peak performance.
- (3) Goal 3 is to produce an enjoyable atmosphere for the cadets to interact and build relations with other brigades in the California
- (4) Conduct a Fair and Even Competition using established standards

d. Objectives:

- (1) 100% of cadets will showcase their knowledge of drill and ceremonies.
- (2) No cadets are injured during the event.

(3) The 10th Corps Staff will enhance their collaborative leadership skills to accomplish the event mission.

e. Cadet Leaders & Staff Assignments: The cadet staff and leaders for this event will be the 10th Corps Staff.

f. Application Process: Brigade Advisors must submit their intent to participate on line at XXXXX no later than 13 March 2019.

g. Cost: There will be no cost for this event.

(7) Unarmed Exhibition Drill

(8) Individual Unarmed Drill Down (Grizzly, Junior & Senior Divisions)

(9) Individual Armed Drill Down (Junior & Senior Divisions)

#### **4. SUSTAINMENT:**

a. Meals: Meals provided for this event are lunch. The Cadet Store will also offer breakfast & snacks for a reasonable cost. Units expecting to eat breakfast are asked to notify the Cadet Store NLT 10 APR.

b. Cadet Store: The Cadet Store will be open at this event with logo items and snacks.

c. Transportation: Commandant(s) and or Brigade Advisor(s) can request transportation support from the HQCACC staff. The state can provide rental vans/cars and reimburse drivers via CalATERS. POC at HQCACC is [operations@cacadets.org](mailto:operations@cacadets.org). All participating teams are responsible for their own transportation to & from JFTB Los Alamitos. All cadets must be present NLT 0700 on 13 April 2019.

d. Billeting: Tents & sleeping bags can be provided to units that show up on 12 April 2019. Participants who wish to stay elsewhere may do so at their own expense. Overnight billeting in a National Guard Armory may also be arranged if you desire.
