

WARNING ORDER 2017-2018-004

1. SITUATION:

- a. Name of Event/Operation: Drill Competition
- b. Date: 14 April 2018
- c. Start and End Times: Competition team leaders check in beginning at 0800. Event will conclude not later than 1700.
- d. Location: Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB)
- e. Brigades Participating: All Brigades with eligible teams.
- f. Participation Requirements: All unit teams who have placed First at their respective Brigade Drill Competition are eligible to compete in this event. Brigades with a strength greater than 800 cadets are authorized to bring their First and Second place winners for each Drill category. The competition will be conducted IAW CR 3-8.
- g. Training Events Planned: N/A

2. MISSION:

- a. The California Cadet Corps Annual Drill Competition will aim to improve cadet knowledge on drill and ceremonies and raise morale and esprit by offering a statewide competition.

3. EXECUTION:

- a. Commander's Intent: To conduct a competitive event that provides unit teams with a healthy environment in which they have the opportunity to display their knowledge of Drill. A sense of unity and camaraderie will be encouraged at the event, thus resulting in a building of character and gaining of greater respect for their peers that can be passed on to our subordinate units aiding in promoting Esprit de Corps.
- b. Concept of Operations: The competition will be conducted on the flight line of JFTB. Judges will be comprised of military personnel, augmented as necessary by CACC personnel. Winners will be recognized at the awards ceremony.
- c. Goals:
 - i. Goal 1 is to create a safe and competitive environment for the cadets to showcase their CACC Drill knowledge.
 - ii. Goal 2 is to enhance the cadet's self-confidence and sense of unity within respective teams in order to drill at peak performance.
 - iii. Goal 3 is to produce an enjoyable atmosphere for the cadets to interact and build relations with other brigades in the California Cadet Corps.

- d. Objectives:
 - i. 100% of cadets will showcase their knowledge of drill and ceremonies.
 - ii. No cadets are injured during the event.
 - iii. The 10th Corps Staff will enhance their collaborative leadership skills to accomplish the event mission.
 - iv. Cadet Leaders and Staff Assignments: The cadet staff and leaders for this event will be the 10th Corps Staff. The adult point of contact will be LTC Contreras (belinda.contreras@cadet.org).
- e. Application Process: Brigade Advisors must submit their intent in this [format](#) to SFC Dionne (dustin.dionne@cadet.org) and the Cadet S-1 (s1@cadet.org) NLT 28 February 18.
- f. Cost: There will be no cost for this event.
- g. Key Suspense Dates:
 - i. Intent Due: All brigade advisors must submit their intent to participate NLT 28 February 18.
 - ii. Rosters Due: All brigades participating must have their rosters submitted by the brigade advisor NLT 24 March 18
 - iii. OPORD Published: 05 March 18
- h. Uniform: All participating cadets must be in either the full Class A or Class B uniform which complies with CR 1-8.
- i. Awards: Awards given at this competition will be as follows, outlined in CR1-1:
 - i. Unarmed Squad (Junior and Senior Division)
 - ii. Unarmed Platoon (Junior and Senior Division)
 - iii. Color Guard (Junior and Senior Division)
 - iv. Armed Squad (Open Division)
 - v. Armed Platoon (Open Division)
 - vi. Platoon Armed Exhibition Drill (Open Division)
 - vii. Platoon Unarmed Exhibition Drill (Open Division)
 - viii. Individual Armed Exhibition Drill (Open Division)
 - ix. Individual Drill (Open Division)

4. SUSTAINMENT:

- a. Meals: Meals will be provided for this event. The Cadet Store will also offer breakfast and lunch and snacks for a reasonable cost.
- b. Cadet Store: The cadet store will be open at this event.

- c. Transportation: All participating teams are responsible for their own transportation to and from Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base. All cadets must arrive NLT 0700 on 12 May 18.
- d. Billeting: Two classrooms will be available to those participants that plan on traveling the day before. Participants who wish to stay elsewhere may do so at their own expense.

5. COMMAND AND CONTROL:

- a. Cadet Commander for this event will be the 10th Corps Commander, C/COL Salazar.
- b. Cadet Command Sergeant Major for this event will be the 10th Corps Command Sergeant Major, C/CSM Quintero.
- c. Corps Staff Advisor: MAJ Archer.
- d. All unit Commandants and individual unit commanders are responsible for the conduct and safety of their cadets.
